Council reconvened from Executive Session following interviews with Interim City Manager candidates.

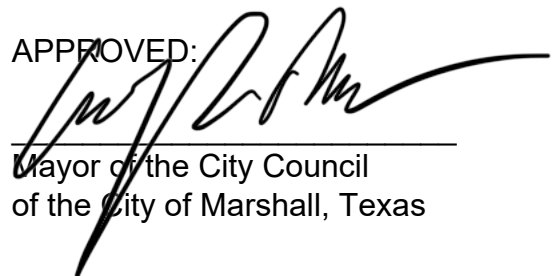
4. Action Item Following Executive Session
